

Reading:

To help with your understanding of our topic on Greek Theatre, I would like you to read the scan of Chapter Ten of *These Were the Greeks* by Amos and Lang on Democracy and Law

(Classical Civilisation Chapter 10 These were the Greeks.pdf).

There will be follow-up work on these chapters when school starts in September.

Writing:

Write a minimum of 300 words and maximum of 500 words in answer to the question:

Why is a study of the ancient civilisations of Greece and Rome still relevant to modern society?

You might like to consider:

- Your own reasons for choosing the subject
- The influence of Greece and Rome on later cultures

You may hand write or word process you answer.
