Y8 onwards

In the second term of Year 8, students begin to personalise their curriculum and choose the path most suited to their pace and abilities. To balance the demands of GCSEs and to further develop learning behaviours, the majority of our students sit one GCSE at the end of Year 10 (some take two). They learn so much from taking a first GCSE in, for example, Classics, Art, History, English Literature, Dance or Drama, and build upon this as they complete all other GCSE courses in Year 11. Our teaching staff are always on hand to help students make the best choices and maximise the opportunities presented to them.

Tutor groups

Vertical tutor groups mean that the same groups are kept in place throughout the main school, ensuring a safe environment and lasting friendships.



Y12 onwards

When it comes to moving up to Year 12, our close links with other schools in the area and excellent reputation mean we are glad to welcome many new students as well as welcoming back those who have progressed through the High Storrs family.

Around two thirds of our students progress into our popular Sixth Form a great testament to their dedication to learning and our record for academic success.
