The Geography team, currently led by Miss Remeikis, is an extremely experienced team of 8 members of staff. Collectively, we have in the region of over 100 years of Geography teaching experience under our belt!

Our Curriculum

At Key Stage 3, the Geography department follows the National Curriculum focussing upon local knowledge (we study Sheffield in Y7), Europe and the wider world (we study Development in Y8 and Globalisation in Y9). The department aims to deliver contemporary, interesting content – we react to Geography in the news to bring what is going on in the real world into the classroom. Pupils are also taught the skills of enquiry and decision-making to encourage curiosity and independent thinking throughout their time at High Storrs. Pupils are taught about how people interact with the environment and they are also given the opportunity to consider alternative environmental futures for the UK and beyond. Our lessons at KS3 prepare students for life at GCSE and A-Level, where we continue our study of some of the main and most important Physical (Rivers, Coasts, Hazards) and Human (Urban Issues, Changing Economies) topics.
